Open to 7<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> graders in the 2023-2024 school year

#### What is a Portfolio?

A portfolio is a resume, or a list, of all the things you've done this year! There are several categories where you list all of the activities you've done. The busier you are, the more stuff you have to put in your portfolio, and the better your 4-H Portfolio will be!

- The portfolios year begins January 1, 2023 and ends December 2023 start listing your activities today!!
- **%** You have two pages to list your accomplishes.
- One page of Supporting Materials color pictures, awards, etc.
- \* Portfolios must be typed. Please submit an electronic copy so the 4-H staff can help edit your portfolio. This is preferred in Google Docs. ClipArt is not allowed. Pictures can only be put on the picture page!
- We will have work sessions to help you get started! Contact the 4-H office to make an appointment.

#### Pick a Project!

The main project category and the sharing and helping category in your portfolio will relate directly to the project area you pick. #### **Categories to Include in Your Portfolio:**

#### **Background Information – 5 Points**

Usually a paragraph about your background in 4-H, how you became interested in the project area, how you became a member of 4-H, family ties to 4-H, or anything else you would like the judges to know about.

#### Main Project Work – 25 Points

Includes anything you've done that is related to your project area. Can include: classes, workshops, tours, interviews, documentaries you've seen, museums visited, articles you've read and more!

#### Main Project Sharing & Helping - 20 Points

# Includes any sharing/teaching others about your project area. Presentations, exhibits, classes, project-related community service, project clubs, mentoring, etc.

# Other Leadership & Teen Leadership Activities – 15 Points

- Includes any leadership activities not reported under main project
- **Examples:** Holding office, serving on committees, serving as a teen leader for an activity, assisting a fellow 4-H'er.
- \* Activities listed here are things you've done all year, not just in 4-H!
- Use active verbs such as: helped, led, taught, organized (these tell exactly what you did)

### Other Community Service & Citizenship Activities – 15 Points

- # Any community service project & citizenship activities not reported under main project work.
- # Include any activities you participated in as an individual or as part of a group for the betterment of a community
- **Examples:** Work with the elderly, disabled, or youth at risk; beautification projects other service activities.
- Activities are not limited to 4-H

#### Other 4-H Activities— 10 Points

- Participation in county, district, region, or state 4-H events
- Includes: 4-H judging events, camp, JR. Conference, 4-H days at UGA, livestock shows, club meetings, fairs, or any 4-H club you may be a part of: horse, archery, shotgun, etc.

#### Other Activities & Information— 5 Points

# Information about school, community, or church activities not listed elsewhere.
