THINGS TO KNOW...

- CHOOSE CAMP BASED ON CHILD'S CURRENT GRADE
 - \$100 DEPOSIT MUST ACCOMPANY REGISTRATION FORM
 - DEPOSITS ARE NON REFUNDABLE AFTER MARCH 31
 - PAYMENTS MAY BE MADE ON REMAINING BALANCE. DUE DATES ARE DIFFERENT FOR EACH CAMP:
 - CLOVERLEAF (5TH/6TH) BALANCE DUE BY MAY 16
 - JUNIOR (7TH/8TH) BALANCE DUE BY MAY 1
 - SENIOR (9TH-12TH) DUE BY MAY 1
 - SCHOLARSHIPS ARE AVAILABLE FOR THOSE WHO CAN DEMONSTRATE FINANCIAL NEED AND ARE ACTIVE IN THE PROGRAM (MEANING PARTICIPATED IN PROJECT ACHIEVEMENT AND/OR CAME TO AT LEAST 3 OUT OF SCHOOL 4-H EVENTS THIS SCHOOL YEAR. CONTACT SHAWNIE FOR DETAILS.)

What to Bring to 4-H Camp

******Everything should be marked in the child's name with a waterproof marker. Do not bring jewelry or other items of value******

Items to Bring:

- FACE COVERINGS--not required, but provide if you want your child to wear one
- Waterproof sunscreen!
- Linens, blankets or sleeping bag (Linens are NOT provided at camp)
- Pillow
- Daily change of clothes and underwear (shorts, tee shirts, etc. Pack clothes that can get dirty and sandy! One or two extra sets of clothes is recommended)
- Shoes and Socks (Bring at least 2 pairs—one that can get wet and muddy)
- Towels (wash cloth, shower towels and beach/pool towels)
- Soap, toothpaste, toothbrush and other toiletries
- Bathing suits--must meet dress code
- Rain jacket
- Sunglasses and/or hat
- Water Bottle (with name CLEARLY marked)
- Money for canteen (store) **7th and up may also go on field trips. Plan accordingly**
- Plastic garbage bag for wet clothes
- Insect Repellent

DO NOT BRING:

- Knives
- Shaving cream
- Fireworks
- Chewing gum
- Excessive amount of cash or items of great value (emotional or monetary)

Optional Items

- Day Pack
- Sport Sandals (the kind with a heel strap are strongly recommended)
- Shower Shoes
- Pen, paper, stamps

Clothing guidelines:

1. No clothing should be worn that violates the Code of Conduct.
2. Underwear should always be worn and should not be visible.
3. Camp is rough on clothes—bring only clothes that are okay to get wet or muddy.
4. Bring extra socks and underwear—you always need them!
