4-H Holiday Card Contest

- 1. Make your drawing on white, **unlined 8.5 by 5.5-inch paper.** This in one half of regular computer printer paper. The size is very important.
- 2. Put your **NAME**, **ADDRESS**, **GRADE**, and **SCHOOL** on the back of the card.
- 3. Include the 4-H symbol, the 4-leaf clover, in your design.
- 4. Submit your card to your teacher before your October club meeting. *This is an excellent way to earn points for club of the month!*


Here are a few helpful hints to make your holiday card:

Do you like to shop or want to learn how to get the most for your money? Then, 4-H Consumer Judging is for You!

Consumer Judging is an after-school activity to prepare for the district competition held in Watkinsville on November 10. In consumer judging students will read details that a person needs when shopping for a particular product. Students will then compare four products in the category and evaluate how each satisfies the stated requirements. The categories for this year's competition are tablets, backpacks, fast food meals and athletic pants.

Workshops will be held at the 4-H office every Monday 4pm to 5:30 pm for six weeks. Workshops begin on Monday, October 3 and run through Monday, November 7. The district competition will be Thursday afternoon, November 10 in Watkinsville. The 4-H Van will transport students to the competition from school on November 10, but parents will need to transport them to Monday workshops.
