- 2. Prepare an 8-10 minute speech for DPA. Time limit is 12 minutes maximum. Exception: Performing Arts Projects 4 minutes maximum; Public Speaking 10 minutes maximum
- 3. You may use posters. Keep them flat so the letters are easy to read. Exception: Public Speaking and Food projects do not need visuals.
- 4. You may use notes. Index cards look more professional than notebook paper.
- 5. Portfolios count 50% and demonstrations count 50% of your total score.

<sup>\*</sup>These projects require food preparation; there is no speech. Food lab competitors must attend a workshop at the 4-H office if you have not previously participated in a 4-H food lab.

<sup>\*\* &</sup>lt;u>Fashion Revue competitors sew and model a garment at the competition.</u> There is no speech in this category but you must be prepared to answer questions regarding construction, fabric care, cost, etc. Competitors should schedule an appointment with 4-H staff to be sure you understand the requirements of this project.
