1. Coastal Plains: Very flat land and warmer temps, row crops

2. Piedmont: Red clay, poor soil for crops, animal agriculture

3. Mountains: High elevations not good for crops due to erosion, lower temperatures

MilkMake Recipe Contest

The dairy industry is an important part of Georgia agriculture. There are currently 200 dairy farms in Georgia that produced over 206 million gallons of milk last year. Milk and milk products are an important source of calcium in our diets. Let's get creative and see if you can create a <u>recipe</u> for <u>a milk shake or smoothie</u>.

Here are a few simple rules:

- 1. Find or make up a recipe for a milk drink. It must have **milk** as one of the ingredients.
- 2. Write out the complete recipe. Make sure it has a title, list of ingredients, and a description of how to make your drink. Be sure to put your name on your recipe.
- 3. Make the drink following your directions.
- 4. Have someone taste it and write their comments.
- 5. Turn in your recipe and your taster's comments at your **February 4-H meeting**.












