If your DPA speech is not completed, please get working on it so that you have plenty of time to practice it before DPA in February. Be sure to have **February 9-11** on your calendars for the DPA contest at Rock Eagle.

JUNIOR 4-H CAMPS

Camp sign-up is now open. A \$100 deposit is required at sign-up. Be sure to get your deposit turned in now so that you won't miss out on a spot for camp. Final payment for any of these camps is due by May 1. Please make monthly payments so that you are not with a huge final payment on May 1.

Junior 4-H Camp will be held at the Fortson 4-H Center **June 25-29, 2018**. Be sure you have these dates on your calendar if you are interested in attending. The cost for camp will be \$365 plus any additional transportation costs.

CLOVERLEAF 4-H DANCE

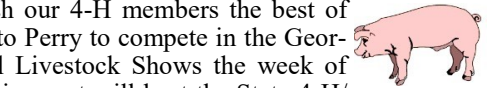

POULTRY JUDGING SIGN UP MEETING

4-H members who want to sign up for the 4-H Poultry Judging Team need to attend the first meeting on **Tuesday, February 27th, at 4 PM until 5 PM in the 4-H office**. Please make arrangements to attend this meeting if you are interested.

In Poultry Judging, you will learn how to compare laying hens to determine the best layer, how to grade eggs by candling, how to judge exterior quality and broken-out eggs, how to grade ready to cook birds, and how to identify different cuts of meat. Practice will be held one to three times a week from February 27th until the contest date of **May 1st**. You will get 50 points toward the 4-H Reward Trip by participating in the Poultry Judging contest. This is the last opportunity to compete in a contest to qualify for the Reward Trip.



JUNIOR/SENIOR PROJECT ACHIEVEMENT
