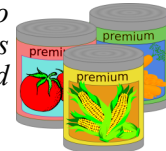


ADOPT-A-HIGHWAY WORKDAY

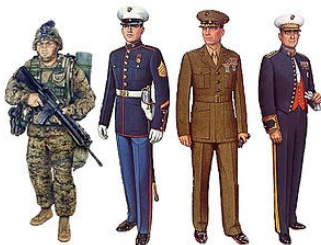
STATE GOAT SHOW
