

BLUEBERRIES:

Cost \$8.00 (1 Gallon)



Blueberries are relatively pest-free and require little care once established. The average family needs 4-6 bushes. Choosing varieties from the different seasons provides a broad harvest season.

Early Season: Climax; Premier
Mid Season: Powder Blue; Brightwell
Late Season: Tifblue; Delite



BLACKBERRIES/RASPBERRIES:

Cost \$8.00 (1 Gallon)



Blackberries and Raspberries are one of the most popular fruits to grow and they are among the easiest for the home gardener to successfully produce. Blackberries and raspberries come as erect types (no trellis required) and trailing types (trellis required) depending on the varieties selected.

Blackberries: Apache; Navaho
Raspberries: Heritage



DWARF POMEGRANATE:

Cost \$20.00 (3 Gallon)



Dwarf Pomegranate is a subtropical deciduous tree that blooms in the summer. This showy, dense, dwarf shrub displays attractive orange-red single flowers at an early age, followed by bright orange-red ornamental fruit. These pygmy trees grow fruit about half the size of ordinary pomegranates.



FERNS:

Cost \$8.00 (1 Gallon)



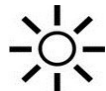
Autumn is a bold and beautiful choice for shady borders and woodland gardens. A dwarf-growing fern with young papery fronds that matures to a deep green.

Tassel is a lustrous, shiny leaf fern which adds an elegant look to shaded gardens. Particularly beautiful when new fronds emerge stiffly, then droop backwards to form a tassel.

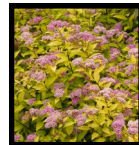


SPIRAEA:

Cost \$8.00 (1 Gallon)



Goldmound is a dense, upright, mounded, deciduous shrub that typically grows 4-6' tall with a slightly larger spread. Leaves (to 3" long) are oval and sharply-toothed. Tiny pink flowers in flat-topped clusters (corymbs) cover the foliage from late spring to mid-summer, with sparse and intermittent repeat bloom sometimes occurring. Flowers are attractive to butterflies.



CAMELLIA:

Cost \$20.00 (3 Gallon)



'Tri Color' features most interesting semi-double blossoms with petals varying from white to pale shades of pink displaying attractive carmine-red streaks. It blooms from January to March and is about 10 feet tall and 6 feet wide.

'October Magic Ivory' is a creamy white, fully double carnation like flower with ruffled petals. Phenomenal early autumn, profuse bloomer with a much more manageable, vigorous, upright habit, on a bushy and easy to produce plant. Reaches 6 to 8 feet in height, and 5 to 7 feet wide.

'Professor Charles Sargent' is an old and reliable favorite. Professor Charles S. Sargent Camellia produces dense rounded flowers that are simply packed with the dark red petals over an extended period from as early as late November to May. Reaches 8 to 12 feet tall and 6 to 10 feet wide.



GARDENIA:

Cost \$8.00 (1 Gallon)



'Frostproof' is a lovely hedge or foundation plant, with a more upright habit with shiny, dark green leaves and large, fragrant blooms that can be smelled from a distance. Frostproof resists late spring frosts without damage unlike typical Gardenia.



AZALEA:

Cost \$8.00 (1 Gallon)



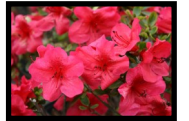
'Hilda Niblett' is a beautiful, low-growing shrub that has the full-size 4-inch flower trusses of much larger Azaleas. One of the main attractions of the 'Hilda Niblett' is the unusual peach and white flowers it produces, that also bear shades of pink and red in early spring. This shade loving shrub will not reach more than a foot high but will spread to about 3-4 feet wide and is trouble-free in even less than perfect soil.



'Mildred' is a low, dwarf to semi-dwarf mounding shrub (3 feet). A profuse bloomer with lavender pink flowers and a compact form. It grows at a slow rate, and under ideal conditions can be expected to live for 40 years or more.



'Hershey Red' is a dwarf to semi-dwarf azalea bush (3 feet) with stunning rose red flowers and a dense, compact form. These flowers look wonderful planted in masses or used in borders. It grows at a slow rate, and under ideal conditions can be expected to live for 40 years or more.



ROSE:

Cost \$20.00 (3 Gallon)



'Coral Drift' has coral colored blooms cover the plant from mid-spring to the first hard freeze of late fall. Easy-care, vigorous and cold hardy. Glossy dark green foliage with excellent disease resistance. Reaches 12 to 18 inches tall and 18 to 24 inches wide.



'Red Drift' are clusters of petite flowers bloom in abundance for an extended season of color. Glossy dark green, disease resistant foliage on a vigorous, hardy, carefree shrub. Perfect for use at the front of borders, or plant to spread gently over a rock wall or along garden pathways. Reaches 12 to 18 inches tall and 18 to 24 inches wide.



'White Drift' has bright white fully double blooms perfectly shaped like a miniature rose flower that blooms from June thru September. Perfect for use at the front of borders, or plant to spread gently over a rock wall or along garden pathways. Reaches 12 to 18 inches tall and 18 to 24 inches wide.



HEUCHERA:

Cost \$8.00 (1 Gallon)



'Amber Lady' features soft, velvety amber leaves with rose pink undersides. A silver marbling overlay adds beauty and dimension to the lobed foliage. A little direct sunlight deepens the colors.



HYDRANGEA:

Cost \$20.00 (3 Gallon)



'Twist & Shout' is the first re-blooming lacecap hydrangea, boasts picturesque deep pink or periwinkle blue hydrangea flowers (depending on soil pH) from late spring through fall. With loads of dependable blooms and intense hydrangea colors, these lacecap hydrangea have become a favorite for everyone. Reaches 3 to 5 feet tall and 3 to 5 feet wide.



'Ruby Blossom' has unique, fully double dark rose-red flowers that are literally petals within petals within ruffled petals on a round ball of bright color. In summer, the rounded, compact plants are smothered in prolifically produced mounds of vibrant blooms.



VIBURNUM:

Cost \$8.00 (1 Gallon)



'Spring Bouquet' is a versatile evergreen shrub that is truly easy to grow. Growing in sun to shade, Spring Bouquet is an excellent addition to the mixed shrub border or used as a low screen. Will grow up to 4 to 6 ft. tall and wide.



'Conoy' is a densely-branched, multi-stemmed shrub which typically grows 4-5' tall and 7-8' wide. It features fragrant, creamy-white flowers arranged in flat-topped umbels in April. Flowers are followed by pendulous clusters of red berry-like drupes which ripen in August and persist into Fall.
