Pierce County

Pierce County producers implement strategies for the management of both the occasional and recurrent pests. Scouting and field monitoring serves as the best strategy for producers to identify insect species and thresholds for needed treatment. On-farm research trials in blueberries provide local and state producers with valuable information on the effectiveness of new products on managing economic pest threats and residual impacts on spring pollinators. Pierce County 4-H serves over 650 students in a variety of in-school, after-school and volunteer led programs. Agriculture, summer camp, project achievement, club meetings and shooting sports are just a few areas Pierce County youth dive into and find their spark!
