## Why Should I Be In 4-H?

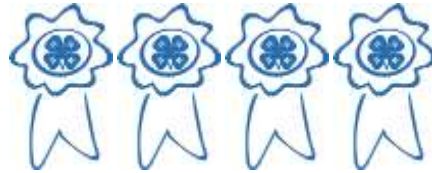
