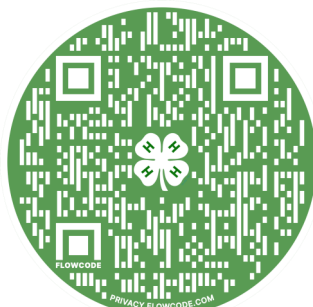

What is Project Achievement?

4-H Project Achievement is like "Show & Tell" for 5th and 6th grade 4-H'ers. You get to talk about ANYTHING that you are interested in and share your interests with others.

Step 1: Pick a Project

Step 2: Research, Write and Design your project presentation. A completed project includes a SPEECH & VISUALS (Slides, posters, or tri-fold display)

Step 3: Share your project at the County Level Project Achievement Contest in February (Date TBA)

Step 4: All county project achievement competitors will have the opportunity to advance to District Project Achievement AND sign up for summer camp EARLY!!
