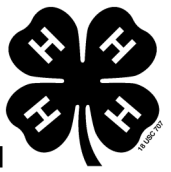

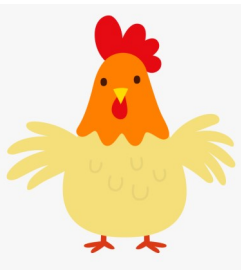
4-H Project Achievement
