___ **Archery**

This class will include a brief history of archery safety rules, instruction for shooting a bow and arrow, and target shooting using light-weight bows. *This is usually to most preferred class; however we are only allotted a few spots. You may not receive this even if you put it as your first choice. Also, it includes a lot of waiting on others to take their turn.*

___ **Gardening**

4-H'ers will learn the basic life-cycle of a plant, from seed to harvest to compost using Rock Eagle's vegetable garden. 4-H'ers will be given the opportunity to plant seeds, harvest vegetables, or help take care of compost while learning what it takes to make plants grow. Campers will get their hands dirty and develop a new appreciation for the amount of work it takes to get food from farm to fork.

___ **Entomology**

Basic information on the "World of Insects". Specifically covers the benefits versus the irritation caused by insects. Displays, collection, exhibits and hands on teaching techniques will make for an interesting and exciting class session.

___ **Forestry**

4-H'ers will learn the basics of Forest Evaluation, Tree Identification, Tree Measurement and Volume Estimation, plus many other important aspects of forest management. Participants will see first hand how forestry management practices can enhance and preserve the forest.

___ **Herpetology**

An informational session on snakes, identification, Do's and Don't's, myths, and benefits. Campers will be given an opportunity to touch and/or handle a live specimen.

___ **Lake Ecology**

This class will help the 4-H'er develop a better understanding of the unique world of life surrounding and within a pond or lake. Plenty of hands-on experiential learning will keep the session alive and very educational.

___ **Wildlife**

This class is a basic introduction to identifying wildlife and learning basic principles about wildlife habitat and survival. This class will explore the wonderful world of Georgia's wildlife and how 4-H'ers can protect and preserve Georgia's natural resources.
