What to Pack?

- Please limit child to one suitcase & one backpack for the bus
- Daily change of clothing & underwear
- Old clothing – T-shirts and shorts are best
- 3 pairs of shoes (shower, dry – sports shoes for walking, wet-water shoes or sandals with heel strap, crocs are allowed but often cause blisters, NO FLIP FLOPS)
- Socks
- Swimsuit (girls must wear a one-piece swim-suit or modest tankini, skirtini, or shortini (or wear a **dark** colored t-shirt over swimsuit that are bikinis and swimsuit deemed inappropriate by 4-H staff)
- Rain gear
- Towels & Washcloths
- Toiletries (shampoo, soap, deodorant, toothbrush, toothpaste, etc.)
- Light Jacket
- Sleeping Bag or Extra Long twin-sized sheets & a pillow

Other things to bring

- Water resistant/proof watch
- Sun block
- Sun glasses or hat
- 5 plastic garbage bags (for dirty clothes)
- Water bottle
- Disposable camera (write full name & county on camera)
- Money for canteen (be sure to include plenty for quarters)
- Any medicines needed (please put in a zip lock bag that is labeled)
- Books to read on the bus
- Playing Cards
- **Please put your child's name on all of their belongings**

What not to bring to camp

- CD players, radios, iPods, walkmans
- Video games
- DVD Players
- Shaving cream (\$175 charge for damages)
- Valuable items (jewelry, favorite anything)
- New clothes or shoes
- Clothing including halter tops, backless shirts, one shoulder tops, **shirts or tank tops with spaghetti straps**, tube tops, extremely tight clothing, **visible midriffs or cleavage**, revealing pants, or clothing with profanity or that advertises alcohol or tobacco products **are NOT allowed**.
- An excessive amount of cash or items of great value (emotional or monetary)
- Cell Phones
- **Georgia 4-H Camping Program does not allow cell phones at Georgia 4-H Camps for the Cloverleaf age group. In those cases where Cloverleaf Campers do bring cell phones to camp, the adult leader/agent from that county will take the cell phone and return it to the parent/guardian at the conclusion of camp.**
