AMMO (Recommendations)

NOTE: Everyone needs to find the ammo that works the best in their own rifle.
Standard velocity is inherently more accurate than high velocity.
Each shooter will need 1500 to 2000 rounds for the season.

REQUIREMENTS:

RIFLE -

Rifles used in the Rimfire Sporter match must be of standard sporter type not exceeding 7 ½ pounds with sights / scopes and magazine. Rifles must have a trigger capable of lifting a 3 pound weight when cocked. Rifles must be chambered for the .22 cal. Long Rifle cartridge. Rifles should be repeater type rifles with magazines capable of holding 5 rounds. Any type feed is acceptable, but semi-auto is preferred. Rifles with clips, box, or tube type magazines are acceptable. However, rifles with removable magazines will be easier for the shooter to use. Magnum rimfire rifles may not be used. Tactical style rifles are not permitted for 4-H competition. Thumbhole stocks, adjustable butt plates, adjustable check pieces, and rails for movable sling swivel's are not permitted. Fluted barrels are also not permitted.

SLING -

A symmetrical web or leather sling no wider than 1 ¼ inches will be used in the prone and kneeling or sitting position. The sling must be attached to a fixed sling swivel. Slings for 4-H competition may be of either target style (cuff sling with single point attachment at the forearm) or hunting / traditional style (two point attachment at stock and forearm). A target style sling will allow for better accuracy.

NOTE: A good target style sling can be purchased from Champion's Choice – www.champchoice.com for \$29. Part number is **SS1000**.

SCOPE/ SIGHTS –

Telescopic, receiver, or open sights may be used. Shooters who use rifles with telescopic or receiver (aperture) sights will compete in the T-class. Scopes are limited to a maximum of six power (6X). If a variable scope is used the power adjustment may not exceed 6X and it must be taped in that location. Any rifles with receiver (aperture or "peep") sights must be used in the T-class. Shooters who use rifles with the open sights compete in the O-class.
