Want to receive a Summer Camp Scholarship?

Fifth and sixth Grade students who compete at Cloverleaf Project Achievement (CPA) at the Athens-Clarke County Cooperative Extension facility on Saturday February 10 and at South Jackson County Middle School on Saturday March 23 can apply for a Summer Camp Scholarship to pay for

most of Rock Eagle Camp Registration fee.

Students are encouraged to do their best at the competitions presenting a 3 to 6 minute speech with a visual aid, like a board or poster, but are not required to win. However, parents must complete the Scholarship Application form after the Jackson County DPA if they want their 4-H'er to receive a camp scholarship for July 8-12. (If student is not winner in first choice at CPA, they can choose and compete an open project for DPA).

The full price for Summer Camp at Rock Eagle is \$340 but if fifth & sixth grade students participate on both dates listed above and submit an application, they can receive scholarship funds to reduce the price for camp to only \$85! Please sign up with their Teacher at school or email Ms. Conway at **ebarber@uga.edu** before February 1 if you want to compete at Cloverleaf Project Achievement (CPA)!

You've had time to think about the October lesson on how to give a speech. Let's put those skills to work and enter the 4-H Project Achievement competition! Now is the time to check out the project listing and choose a subject in which you are interested. Project Fun Day takes place on Saturday, February 10, 2024 9:30 amNoon at the ACC 4-H Cooperative Extension Facility.

To participate in this competition students present a 3 to 6 minute informative speech about their topic, using visuals such as posters or items to enhance the demonstration. <u>Unfortunately in this 4-H competition we cannot use PowerPoint or similar computer generated programs for these presentations.</u> There are few exceptions to the speech requirement that were outlined on your project list sheet, Students interested in the Food Lab Projects: Between Meal Snacks or Food Fare category must make an appointment with 4-H staff to learn about the special requirements for those projects. You and a parent will need to meet with 4-H staff before competing in either.

Students compete against other students who are presenting the same category/project they have selected. Judges will listen to each presentation and award points in the following manner. *Appearance, Visual aids, Delivery, Orderly Process, Accuracy of Information, Coverage of Subject, Knowledge of Subject, and Time Limit.* As a bonus, winners from the CPA competition in February will earn the opportunity to travel to Jackson County to compete in the District Contest (DPA) on March 23.
