

- In 1904, Mr. GC Adams started the Boys Corn Club in Newton County
- A Girls Tomato Canning Club was started in Hancock County
- In 1914, Smith-Lever Act established Cooperative Extension Service (4-H) which is service part of UGA

 - <u>Reporter</u>: Friends Books & Reads poem or quote from packet or your own selection
- Competitions and contests
- Project Achievement
- Helping others
- Summer activities






4-H Holiday Card Contest
