- Financial Aid Scholarship – New and Returning 4-H’ers
  - This scholarship is for youth who cannot attend camp without a scholarship. Previous 4-H experience or participation in Cloverleaf Project Achievement does not impact the youth’s application.
  
- Cloverleaf CAMP Access Partial Scholarship (\$200) – New 4-6<sup>th</sup> Grade 4-H’ers  
To be eligible for CAMP Access Scholarships, 4-H’ers must:
  - First-time camper
  - Demonstrate financial need.

  - Be eligible to attend Cloverleaf Camp
  - Be affiliated with the Air Force (priority groups are listed in order)
    - Deployment status (upcoming 6 months, recently deployed within 6 months, or currently)
    - Reserve and Guard dependents
    - Active-duty Air Force dependents
    - A wounded veteran of the Air Force
    - Fully retired service members
    - Civilians working on an installation
