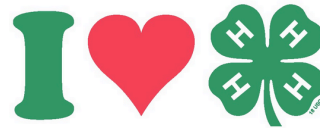

Calling all 6th-8th grade 4-Hers! Come spend the weekend at Rock Eagle 4-H Center November 9-10, 2024. Participate in exciting workshops, recreation, community service projects, talent show, and enjoy the dance, and Georgia 4-H’s own performing arts group, Clovers and Company. The price for Junior Conference is \$55 for the first 4 6th-8th graders to pay and register. Additional registration will be \$105 per student.

If selected as a workshop leader it will be a prepared workshop in Healthy Living. The cost is \$50 and teen leaders must be able to attend the entire weekend.
