

Cobb County 4-H Marietta, GA 30060 770-528-4070 Junior/Senior Camp Scholarship Application



Cobb County 4-H is providing partial scholarships to selected young people attending a specialty camp including Junior Camp, Wilderness Challenge Camp, Senior Camp, or Senior Extreme Camp. The scholarship is for \$100 off the cost of camp. Parents are required to pay the remainder of the camp fee including the deposit.

Partial scholarships will be provided to a limited number of 4-H'ers. There are several requirements that must be met before funds are awarded. There will be an extensive screening process in selecting scholarship recipients. To be eligible for the Cobb County 4-H Scholarship to attend camp, 4-H'ers must:

- Indicate in a 1-page essay how they became involved with 4-H and list what they have learned through their 4-H activities either at school, during County Council, while attending Project Achievement or any other 4-H events/activities.
- Have a **Letter of Recommendation** from a current teacher.
- Completed application form below.

<u>All applicants are required to register and pay the \$100.00 non-refundable deposit due by Monday, February</u> <u>3rd by 5 PM.</u>

The deadline to submit the application, essay, and teacher letter of recommendation to the Extension Office is **January 31, 2025.** No late applications will be accepted.

Notification of awarded scholarships will be emailed to 4-H'ers and parents by Monday, February 10, 2025.
