Blueberry– 1 gallon

Price: \$9.00

Blueberries are relatively pest free and require little care once established. Plant at least two bushes, each of a different variety for cross-pollination.

Austin: Large berry, Early - mid season

Brightwell: Medium berries, Mid season

Pink Lemonade: Medium sweet pink berry, Late season

Tift Blue: Larger berry, Late season

Sunlight needed: Full Sun

Achillea - 'Desert Eve Red'– 1 gallon

Price: \$9.00

A carefree, compact, early-flowering variety with vibrant blooms and ferny foliage. Big, flat clusters of small, deep brick-red flowers attract butterflies. Heat loving, waterwise, fuss-free color for sunny borders or containers.

Sunlight needed: Full Sun

Bloom Season: Summer

Flowers: Brick Red

Agastache- 'Kudos Ambrosia'– 1 gallon

Price: \$9.00

The pale orange and rose pink spikes are highlighted with creamy white. With its scented foliage, Agastache are a living garden potpourri. An appealing perennial for summer through fall color in a sun-loving garden. Attractive to hummingbirds, butterflies and all pollinators. Goldfinches love the seed.

Sunlight needed: Full Sun to Mostly Sunny

Bloom Season: Early Summer to Early Fall

Flowers: Pale Orange and Rose Pink

Azalea - 'Delaware Valley'– 1 gallon

Price: \$8.00

A dazzling display of lightly fragranced white bell shaped flowers and dark green, evergreen leaves. Bouquets of flowers are formed in tight clusters at the ends of each branch. The striking, scented flowers attract butterflies to your garden. A bush that can reach 3-4 ft. high and wide.

Sunlight needed: Full to Partial Sun

Bloom Season: Spring

Flowers: White

Azalea - 'Hino Crimson'– 1 gallon

Price: \$8.00

A relatively small rhododendron that explodes with crimson color each spring. Showy, single flowers appear all over the shrub. The crimson red blooms amass on a low-growing plant with small green leaves. The semi-evergreen shrub keeps its leaves in winter and drops the old leaves just as it forms new ones.

Sunlight needed: Partial Sun to Partial Shade

Bloom Season: Early Spring

Flowers: Red

Azalea - 'Renee Michelle'– 1 gallon

Price: \$8.00

A profusion of bubblegum pink and easy-care evergreen foliage makes Renee Michelle Azalea. An excellent choice for showy, low-maintenance gardening. Beginning late April, slightly ruffled bright pink flowers with deeper rose accents cover this petite evergreen shrub.

Sunlight needed: Shade to Partial Shade

Bloom Season: Spring

Flowers: Pink

Azalea Native- 'Tallulah Sunrise'– 3 gallon

Price: \$18.00

Growing 6 to 8 feet in height and 5 to 6 feet wide, the Tallulah Sunrise Native Azalea is ideal for use in woodland gardens and shady flowering shrub borders. The flowers produce a honeysuckle-like fragrance. Very lustrous dark green leaves turn orange-bronze in fall.

Sunlight needed: Shade or mostly shade

Bloom Season: Early Spring

Flowers: Bright Orange

Camellia Japonica- 'Professor Sargent'– 1 gallon

Price: \$9.00

Professor Sargent Camellia produces an abundance of stunningly gorgeous, fully double, peony-like brilliant red flowers that begin opening in late winter continuing through mid-spring. Even when not in bloom, the large, lustrous, evergreen, dark green leaves provide outstanding texture in the landscape.

Sunlight needed: Partial Shade

Bloom season: Early Spring

Flowers: Vivid Crimson Red

Camellia Sasanqua- 'Maggie's Pink'– 1 gallon

Price: \$9.00

Beautiful new fall blooming Camellia. 'Maggie's Pink' is a sport (mutation) from 'Yuletide', one of, if not the most popular of all Camellia Sasanqua varieties. She has all the outstanding characteristics of her parent except with pink petals, but with the same prominent patch of bright golden yellow stamens.

Sunlight needed: Partial Sun to Partial Shade

Bloom season: Fall

Flowers: Pink with bright yellow stamens

Coreopsis- 'Nana'– 1 gallon

Price: \$9.00

Coreopsis auriculata 'Nana', also known as Mouse-Ear Tickseed, forms bright golden-yellow daisies in late spring and early summer and again in fall. Its warm green, spreading evergreen foliage turns burgundy in fall.

Sunlight needed: Full Sun to Light Shade

Bloom season: Early Summer to Early Fall

Flowers: Golden Yellow

Dianthus- 'Key Lime'– 1 gallon

Price: \$9.00

A versatile perennial; it is at home in mixed borders, containers, butterfly, heirloom and cutting gardens. Noted for larger flowers on sturdy stems.

Sunlight needed: Full Sun

Bloom Season: Late Spring to Mid-Summer

Flowers: White Flower with apple green eye

Echinacea- 'Cheyenne '– 1 gallon

Price: \$10.00

A delight to any space, this herbaceous perennial blooms with all the colors of summer. Since the 1700s, the Cheyenne Spirit Echinacea has graced gardens as a low-maintenance, drought-tolerant plant that attracts an array of friendly pollinators.

Sunlight needed: Full Sun

Bloom Season: Summer

Flowers: Mix of flower colors including gold, scarlet, orange, rose-red, cream, purple and yellow

Fern—'Holly' - 1 gallon

Price: \$8.00

This evergreen fern makes an excellent groundcover or border edging in shaded locations. The stiff, glossy, dark green fronds of holly-like leaflets with coarsely fringed margins add excellent texture to container plantings.

Sunlight needed: Full Shade to Partial Shade

Leaves: Green

Fern—'Tassel' - 1 gallon

Price: \$8.00

An evergreen fern with shiny, dark green fronds that can bring beauty to your garden. This hardy fern looks good all year round and combines well with colorful heucheras, hostas, and other shade plants. Plant height will mature at approximately 2ft tall with a 2 ft spread.

Sunlight needed: Part Shade to Full Shade

Leaves: Green

Fothergilla 'Mount Airy'– 1 gallon

Price: \$8.00

Deciduous shrub with deep blue-green leaves has attractive fall color. Honey-scented, brush-like flowers appear before the leaves. Beautiful addition to shrub borders or for background in semi-shaded borders.

Sunlight needed: Full Shade to Partial Sun

Bloom Season: Spring

Flowers: Showy White

Gaillardia– 'Spin Top Red Starburst'– 1 gallon

Price: \$9.00

Gaillardia Spin Top Red features an excellent branching habit with multiple buds on every stem. Compact, uniform and extremely early flowering, this series demonstrates excellent heat tolerance in all regions. Large flowerheads are pollinator favorites. Very drought resistant.

Sunlight needed: Full Sun

Bloom Season: Late Spring through Summer

Flowers: Red Orange Flower

Gardenia- 'Frost Proof' - 1 gallon

Price: \$8.00

This plant has a nice symmetrical upright form with very attractive narrow green foliage. It can be maintained in a pot, but grows to 3 feet tall outdoors. It requires moist, somewhat acidic soil.

Sunlight needed: Full Sun to Partial Sun

Bloom Season: Summer

Flowers: White

Gaura- 'Belleza Dark Pink' - 1 gallon

Price: \$9.00

Long-blooming Wandflower, beginning in early summer and continuing through early fall. Wandflower, also called Beeflower, is a favorite of bumblebees that will make its long airy stems bob up and down.

Sunlight needed: Full Sun to Partial Shade

Bloom Season: Late Spring - Late Fall

Flowers: Pink

Geranium- 'Blushing Turtle' - 1 gallon

Price: \$9.00

Blushing Turtle Hardy Geranium Plants bring delicate-looking, bright pink blooms with light veining on the petals and a vigorous, low growing habit that makes it perfect as an attractive ground cover. This deer-resistant plant is easy to grow and tolerates some drought.

Sunlight needed: Full Sun to Partial Shade

Bloom Season: Late Spring - Early Fall

Flowers: Pink

Heuchera - Amber Lady - 1 gallon

Price: \$9.00

Heuchera Amber Lady's features soft, velvety amber leaves with rose pink undersides. A silver marbling overlay adds beauty and dimension to the lobed foliage. Deer resistant.

Sunlight needed: Full Sun to Partial Shade

Bloom Season: Mid-Summer

Leaves: Amber with Rose Pink Undersides

Heuchera - Caramel - 1 gallon

Price: \$9.00

New leaves emerge bright gold and mature to a peachy orange. Thrives in the high heat and humidity of the South. Evergreen in mild winter areas.

Sunlight needed: Partial Sun to Full Sun

Bloom Season: Summer

Leaves: Bright Gold to Peachy Orange

Heucherella -Stoplight- 1 gallon

Price: \$9.00

This cross of coral bell and foamflower has amazing chartreuse foliage with red veins. The plants foliage is enough of a reason to plant it but it does flower too! Grows up to about 18'.

Sunlight needed: Partial Shade to Full Shade

Bloom Season: Late Spring

Leaves: Green, Lime, Red, Yellow

Hosta 'June'- 1 gallon

Price: \$10.00

The compact, variegated 'June' Hosta is a lively addition to any garden space! Heart-shaped leaves are variegated with blue-green margins and yellow centers. Racemes of bell-shaped, lavender flowers hover 20' over the foliage.

Sunlight needed: Full Shade to Partial Sun

Bloom Season: Spring through Fall

Flowers: Pale Lavender

Hosta 'Minuteman'- 1 gallon

Price: \$10.00

Satiny green leaves are surrounded by creamy white margins. Large, funnel-shaped flowers are dark lavender. A sun tolerant selection. Ideal for adding exuberant color to shady gardens. The thick foliage resists slug damage. An herbaceous perennial.

Sunlight needed: Full Shade to Partial Sun

Bloom Season: Summer

Leaves: Green with White Margins

Flowers: Purple

Hydrangea 'Limelight'- 1 gallon

Price: \$10.00

Football-shaped flowers open in an elegant celadon green that looks fresh and clean in summer's heat. The blooms age to an array of pink, red, and burgundy which persists through frost for months of irresistible flowers. You can use 'Limelight' hydrangea just about any way you can imagine: as a showy flowering hedge, to screen off air conditioners, as an attention-getting specimen, in containers, flower gardens, or anywhere around your home.

Sunlight needed: Partial Sun to Full Sun

Bloom Season: Summer through Fall

Flowers: Green

Hydrangea 'Merritt's Supreme'- 1 gallon

Price: \$10.00

A compact and dense grower, 'Merritt's Supreme' is a choice addition to the smaller garden. The stocky thick branches and dense foliage create a full looking deciduous shrub maturing to about 4 feet tall.

Sunlight needed: Partial Sun to Partial Shade

Bloom Season: Summer

Flowers: Violet

Hydrangea Snow Queen 'Oakleaf Hydrangea'- 3 gallon

Price: \$18.00

Large, dense 6 to 8 inch long clusters of white flowers are held upright above the dark green oak leaf-shaped foliage. Flowers become rose-pink in the fall and leaves turn deep red-bronze.

Sunlight needed: Partial Sun

Bloom Season: Spring-Summer

Flowers: White (Spring-Summer), Rose-Pink (Fall)

Lavandula 'Munstead' - 1 gallon

Price: \$9.00

A rugged yet beautiful compact evergreen shrub with mounding, aromatic, gray foliage and an abundance of fragrant, rich lavender-colored flower spikes. Commonly used for perfumes, sachets, and oils.

Sunlight needed: Full Sun

Bloom Season: Late Spring to Early Summer

Flowers: Lavender

Lavender 'Grosso' - 2 gallon

Price: \$20.00

A large growing French hybrid lavender with dark blue flower spikes in mid-summer. An impressive profuse bloomer ideal for drying or culinary use.

Sunlight needed: Full Sun

Bloom Season: Summer

Flowers: Lavender

Magnolia 'Brittany' - 3 gallon

Price: \$22.00

The perfect fit for those with limited space but want the beauty and fragrance of Southern magnolia. The 'Brittany' is a dwarf magnolia maturing to a height of 15-20 feet and a width of 8-10 feet. Produces large showy white flowers that are up to 10 inches across.

Sunlight needed: Full Sun to Mostly Sun

Bloom Season: Summer

Flowers: White

Monarda 'Balmy' - 1 gallon

Price: \$9.00

A showy perennial offering early summer interest. Heavy blooming, the plant sets shaggy, globular, boldly colored flower heads in a bright shade of purple. Borne singly atop long, willowy, square stems, the eye-catching, nectar-rich blossoms come in abundance; attract tons of bees, butterflies, and hummingbirds; and make excellent cuts for vase or arrangements.

Sunlight needed: Full Sun, Partial Shade

Bloom Season: Early Summer

Flowers: Purple

Osmanthus Fragrans 'Tea Olive' - 1 gallon

Price: \$9.00

A large evergreen shrub or small tree with an upright form that is densely branched and covered with dark green foliage. Tiny flower clusters have a delightful apricot-like fragrance. Plant tea olive near walks and entrances to enjoy the fragrance.

Sunlight needed: Partial Sun to Full Sun

Bloom Season: Spring

Flowers: White

Phlox Paniculata 'Early Purple Eye' - 1 gallon

Price: \$9.00

Pollinators will keep your garden abuzz as they visit these nectar-rich purple and white bicolor beauties. Early blooming, open clusters crowd the compact, bushy foliage.

Sunlight needed: Full Sun

Bloom Season: Late Spring to Mid-Summer

Flowers: Purple

Phlox 'Woodlander Lilac'– 1 gallon

Price: \$9.00

This creeping phlox variety dazzles with enormous clusters of extra-large blooms, outshining the typical subulata species with a vibrant carpet of 5-petaled flowers in captivating shades of lilac. Adored by bees and butterflies.

Sunlight needed: Full Sun, Partial Shade

Bloom Season: Early Spring

Flowers: Lavender

Rose Brindabella- 'First Lady'– 1 gallon

Price: \$14.00

Brindabella Roses™, a collection of tough shrub roses selected for superior garden performance and show stopping flowers: bushy growth habits, excellent disease resistance to black spot and powdery mildew, and fragrant doubled flowers. These low maintenance roses are very vigorous yet grow to only 4 feet tall and wide in 2 years' time.

Sunlight needed: Full Sun to Part Shade

Bloom season: Spring– Summer

Flowers: Lavender-Pink

Rosemary 'Tuscan Blue'- 1 gallon

Price: \$9.00

Quickly forms an upright hedge of aromatic, needle-like evergreen foliage. Profuse clear blue flowers add a charming effect. Leaves can be used as a flavorful herb in cooking. Takes to pruning well, but is equally wonderful when left in natural rustic form without pruning.

Sunlight needed: Full Sun

Bloom Season: Spring through Summer

Flowers: Blue flower, green foliage

Rudbeckia 'American Gold Rush'- 1 gallon

Price: \$8.00

A compact, clump-forming perennial boasting masses of golden-yellow daisies, 2 in. across, adorned with a dark central cone.

Sunlight needed: Full Sun

Bloom Season: Summer- Early Fall

Flowers: Yellow - Gold

Salvia 'Radio Red'-1 gallon

Price: \$9.00

Aromatic sage with true rich red color, that doesn't fade away. Very long flowering season, more upright and a bit irregular growing habit. Highly attractive to hummingbirds! For sunny beds, containers or larger pots.

Sunlight needed: Full Sun to Mostly Sunny

Bloom Season: Early to Mid-Spring

Flowers: Red

Scabiosa 'Blue Butterfly'-1 gallon

Price: \$9.00

A rich blue frilly skirt of petals surrounds a silvery central 'pincushion' of this Scabiosa. One of the longest flowering perennials.

Multiple pincushion shaped flowers produced all season. Very compact with ferny blue-grey foliage.

Sunlight needed: Full Sun

Bloom Season: Late Spring to Early Fall

Flowers: Lavender blue

Veronica 'Sky Blue Moody Blue'-1 gallon

Price: \$9.00

A compact plant that produces spikes of medium to light blue flowers all season long. This perennial is great for borders or containers providing an upward punch of blue.

Sunlight needed: Full Sun

Bloom Season: Spring to Summer

Flowers: Blue

Viburnum 'Spring Bouquet'-1 gallon

Price: \$8.00

The Spring Bouquet Viburnum is a beautiful semi-evergreen flowering shrub with delicately fragrant pinkish-white blossoms and dark green leaves. The lightly fragrant flowers cluster into groups during the early spring growing season and are star-shaped.

Sunlight needed: Full Sun / Partial Shade

Bloom Season: Early Spring

Flowers: Pink/White

Viburnum 'Summer Snowflake'-1 gallon

Price: \$8.00

Doublefile viburnum is a dense multi-stemmed shrub that matures at a height of 5 to 8 feet and features showy white flowers in late spring and sporadically in summer.

Sunlight needed: Partial Sun to Full Sun

Bloom Season: Late Spring

Flowers: White

Vitex 'Shoal Creek'-1 gallon

Price: \$9.00

Shoal Creek Vitex, also called Chastetree, is a long-blooming small tree (or shrub) that is often planted around porches, patios, and decks for its beautiful summer flowers and its ability to attract butterflies. Chastetree blooms in the summer in clusters of violet flowers that resemble spikes. Besides its beauty, the leaves of the Chastetree also boast of an aromatic quality.

Sunlight needed: Full Sun

Bloom Season: Summer
