## Science Fun - STEM Ambassador - Prayushi Padhi

The heat from the oven causes the proteins in the turkey to denature and congeal, which means they change shape and solidify, making the meat firm and giving it that delicious texture we all love.

Another cool science fact about Thanksgiving involves the cranberries in your favorite sauce. Cranberries contain pectin, a type of carbohydrate that helps the sauce thicken as it cools. When you cook cranberries with sugar and water, the pectin is released and forms a gel-like consistency, which is why cranberry sauce sets so nicely. So, next time you're enjoying your Thanksgiving meal, remember that there's a lot of science happening right on your plate!
