
The excitement and adventure at Wilderness Challenge Camp never stops! Are you ready to jump in?

Camp Registration

Camp Registration will open online Monday February 9th at 8:00 am. Once you complete the Cobb 4-H Online camp registration, a 4-H staff member will reach out to you via email to confirm your child's registration with instructions on paying the required deposit. You will have two business days from the date of the confirmation email to complete payment to officially secure your child's space.

2026 Wilderness Challenge Camp Cost – \$460.00

- Price includes lodging, meals, transportation, insurance, camp t-shirt, and all camp activities.
- A non-refundable deposit of \$100.00 is due at registration to reserve your child's space.
- The deadline to pay the final payment of \$360.00 is Monday, April 27th. Additional split payments will gladly be accepted until the April 27th, deadline.
- Payments can be made via cash, check, or Visa/Master Card/Discover. All checks should be made out to Cobb County Extension/4-H. Phone payments will be accepted at 770-528-4070 after the initial registration and deposit.
- Refund Policy per Cobb Extension Office: NO refunds at all AFTER March 26th, 2026.
- Limited partial scholarships are available. Scholarship applications and teacher recommendation letters are due to the Cobb Extension office by January 30th.

Cobb County 4-H Camp Registration

- Camp registration will open Monday, February 9th at 8:00 am online.

- Registration is limited to 22 participants. Spaces fill quickly. A waiting list will be created once spaces fill.

- Transportation by Cobb County 4-H is limited to 22 spaces.
