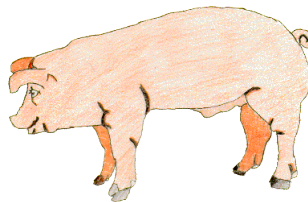
### ADOPT-A-HIGHWAY WORKDAY

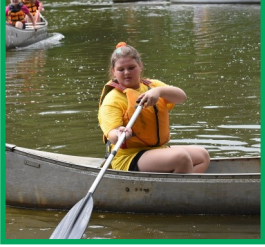
