**WHAT:** This activity teaches young people how to research, develop, and present a **5-minute “show and tell” project** using posters and props on a topic that interests them. These communication skills help prepare students not only for the Georgia Writing Assessment, but also for life! At the event, 4-H’ers will compete with other counties in their project area. All 4-H’ers receive a special 4-H participation ribbon and **1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners** receive additional recognition. By participating, your child is eligible for various **scholarship opportunities!**

**WHO:** Any 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, or 6<sup>th</sup> grader who lives or goes to school in Columbia County is eligible to attend including private & home schools. The child **does not** currently have to be a 4-H member to attend.

**WHERE:** The largest 4-H center in the world, **Rock Eagle 4-H Center!** The center is located 90 miles away in **Eatonton, GA**. Transportation is provided by Columbia County school buses. Chaperones are 4-H staff and screened & certified volunteers.

**WHEN:** Students will ride on Columbia County school buses. We will meet to depart for Rock Eagle from a centralized location **at 4 pm on Friday, November 12.**

**FUN:** Definitely! You will stay in a **cabin** with your friends Friday night, including a **dance**, a **pizza party**, and **recreation**. The concession stand will be open to purchase all your favorite foods and snacks. All meals are included in the fee – Dinner on Friday, breakfast and lunch on Saturday.

## TIPS FOR PICKING A PROJECT AREA

- Think about what topic you would like to present. Then look to see which category that topic might fit under. **EXAMPLES:** How a car engine works → Engineering & Mechanics, How to prevent heatstroke → Health, Day of the Dead Celebration → International, etc. **NOTE: Live animals cannot be used in any project area.**
- Please read the project area descriptions *carefully*. Some do not require a speech or posters but instead require a performance, cooking demonstration, only a speech, or the creation of an item. **THESE PROJECTS HAVE DIFFERENT RULES & SCORECARDS.**
- **PERFORMING ARTS** areas require an audition at the Extension/4-H office in Appling. Call by **OCTOBER 8** to reserve an audition time. Performances should be 3-4 minutes & should abide by the 4-H Code of Conduct. If singing or playing an instrument, please have at least two song options to perform.

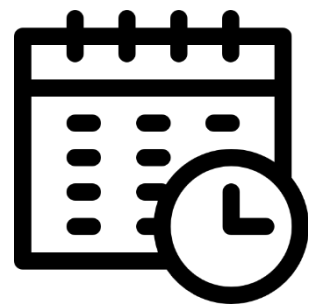
## MANDATORY IN-PERSON ORIENTATION MEETING
