Students will receive **.40 cents** in 4-H credit per meat stick sold. These 4-H funds can be used towards the payment of any 4-H activity or event through school calendar year. Meat sticks can be sold year-round.

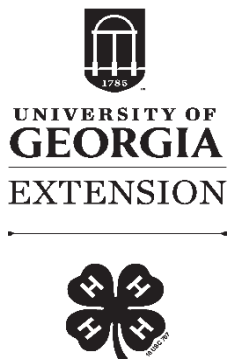
