- Feed & Hay: \$250 (feed) &

- Rope Halter: \$10
- Show Halter: Leather \$60
- Show number harness: \$20
- Water bucket/Feed pan: \$30
- Grooming bucket: (approx. \$25)
  - Shampoo Dish washing liquid is fine
  - Brush
  - Scrubber for washing
  - Rags
  - Alcohol
  - Paper Towels
- Show "whites" (white jeans and white button down, long sleeved shirt): \$60
