

**BLUEBERRIES: Cost \$8.00 (1 Gallon)**

Blueberries are relatively pest-free and require little care once established. The average family needs 4-6 plants. Choosing varieties from the different seasons provides a broad harvest season.



*Early Season: Climax; Premier*  
*Mid Season: Powder Blue; Brightwell*  
*Late Season: Tifblue; Delite*

**BLACKBERRIES/RASPBERRIES:**

Cost \$8.00 (1 Gallon)



Blackberries and Raspberries are one of the most popular fruits to grow and are among the easiest for the home gardener to successfully produce. Blackberries and raspberries come as erect types (no trellis required) and trailing types (trellis required) depending on the variety selected.



**JAPANESE PERSIMMONS**

Cost \$20.00 (3 Gallon)



Fuyu an outstanding deciduous fruit tree with highly ornamental qualities, grown on superior Diospyros lotus rootstock. Fall foliage is a brilliant orange-red. Showy, bright orange-scarlet fruit ripens in late fall and remains on the bare stems well into the winter. Non-astringent, firm-fleshed fruit is best if given time to soften slightly after

**FIGS:**

Cost \$8.00 (1 Gallon)



'Figs' Are very tasty and can be eaten fresh, preserved, or used for baking and making desserts like pie. Figs will do well in most parts of Georgia except the mountainous areas.

**Celeste: small to medium size; Brown Turkey: medium to large size**

**GIANT LEOPARD:**

Cost \$8.00 (1 Gallon)



**Gigantea'** Large, rounded, shiny green leaves show individually on 3 to 4 ft. tall stalks. Daisy-like yellow flowers bloom on tall, branched stems. Thick leaves reach up to 18 inches across and provide an interesting display when massed under trees, in a shady border or in a patio container.

**CAMELLIA:**

Cost \$20.00 (3 Gallon)



**'Tri Color'** features interesting semi-double blossoms with petals varying from white to pale shades of pink displaying attractive carmine-red streaks. It blooms from January to March and is about 10 feet tall and 6 feet wide.



**'Black Magic'** Is sure to cast a spell on anyone gazing upon its deep dark red, wavy petal and double Blossoms. It blooms from January to April and is about 12 feet tall and 10 feet wide.

**GARDENIA:**

Cost \$8.00 (1 Gallon)



**Frostproof'** is a lovely hedge or foundation plant, with an upright growth habit with shiny, dark green leaves and large, fragrant blooms. Frostproof resists late spring frost damage unlike typical Gardenia.

**BUDDLEIA**

Cost \$20.00 (3 Gallon)



**'Pugster Amethyst'** The newest member of this unique series that offers full sized flowers on a dwarf plant. This compact butterfly bush reaches just 2 ft. tall and wide but has the large, full flowers normally seen on larger plants. It blooms non-stop from early summer through frost with amethyst-toned flowers, each with a tiny yellow-orange eye in the center. Thanks to thick, sturdy stems, the Pugster® series offers vastly improved hardiness and winter survival over other types of dwarf butterfly bush.

**AZALEA:**

**'Encore Autumn Royalty'**



Cost \$20.00 (3Gallon)



Is known for its repeating blooms and sun tolerance that will burst into floral perfection in spring and provide you with an "encore " of the performance in the fall. This plant grows 4.5ft tall and 4ft. Wide.

**'Azalea 'Encore Autumn Fire'**

Cost \$25.00 (3Gallon)



This dwarf azalea packs a powerful punch of rich, true color with semi-double velvety blooms. Its glossy, dark green foliage deepens to a saturated purple bronze in winter adding year-round appeal to gardens. It reaches 2.5 ft tall and 3 ft. wide.

**Azalea Tallulah Sunrise'**

Cost \$20.00 (3Gallon)



A gorgeous native azalea with clusters of fragrant orange flowers that blooms from March thru April. Grows about 5ft. tall and prefers part shade.

**HEUCHERA:**

Cost \$10.00 (1 Gallon)



**'Black Taffeta'** Features silky black, heavily-ruffled foliage that adds a black-tie elegance to any garden. This clump-forming perennial forms basal mounds, up to 12 inches tall with a spread of 15 inches.

**HEUCHERELLA**

Cost \$10.00 (1 Gallon)



**'Spotlight'** This perennial forms a low mound of bright-yellow leaves with a star-shaped center marking of beet red. Short spikes of white flowers appear in late spring. Leaves change to green with red markings during the summer. Nice choice for the woodland garden, or for edging in a shady perennial border or rock garden.

**HELLEBORUS**

Cost \$10.00 (1 Gallon)



**'Orientalis Mixed'** Various shades of single-flowered, cup-shaped blooms combined in this splendid mix. Flowers appear February-March depending on climate and attracts pollinators. Because hellebores are extremely long-lived perennials, they are excellent for woodland gardens or shady borders.

**HYDRANGEA: Cost \$25.00 (3 Gallon)**



**'Firelight'** Is the standard to measure all panicle hydrangeas! It is known for its huge, full flower heads and sturdy, strong stems whose blooms emerge creamy-white and age to a vivid red for lots of summer color. It makes a great cut flower, fresh or dried, and can be used as a hedge, specimen, or incorporated into flower gardens and foundation plantings. Reaches 8 feet tall and 8 feet wide.

**'Invincibelle Wee White'** |

Is positively ground breaking: It's the first dwarf 'Annabelle' type hydrangea in the world! This cute little landscape plant ensures that any landscape can enjoy the reliability, low maintenance, and season-long beauty of hydrangeas. It reaches just 1-2.5 ft. tall and naturally grows as a tidy, rounded mound.



**Fern:**

Cost \$8.00 (1 Gallon)



**Autumn** is a bold and beautiful choice for shady borders and woodland gardens. A dwarf-growing fern with young papery fronds that emerge a copper-red color and matures to a deep green.

**Viburnum**

**'Spring Bouquet'** s a versatile evergreen shrub that is truly easy to grow. Growing in sun to shade, Spring Bouquet is an excellent addition to the mixed shrub border or used as a low screen. Will grow up to 4 to 6 ft. tall and wide.
