EXHIBIT BOOTH DIMENSIONS

Booth Floor - 26" x 27" 26" Wide X 26" Deep X 27" High

Booths do vary slightly so measure about an inch shy of the actual booth size to be sure it will slide in easily if you are creating an insert.

RULES FOR ENTERING

- Assistance from family members is permitted, but all work must be original. Plagiarism will not be tolerated.
- Booth must comply with the GA 4-H Code of Conduct.
- Please do not reuse exhibits from a previous year.
- Booths will be judged before the fair opens on Thursday.
- The Effingham County Fair Grounds & Effingham County 4-H will not be responsible for any items in the booths; however, wiring will be put over your booth to protect the contents.
- Spaces are limited. If you decide NOT to enter your exhibit booth in the fair, please contact the 4-H Office by October 1st at 912-754-8040 so we can fill the space from the waiting list.

SUGGESTED MATERIALS

- Foam boards (can stand alone in the booths)
- Cardboard cut to dimensions of the booth
- Tri-boards (Recommended they be cut to the size of booth)
- Wooden boards
- Use rubber cement, hot glue, or another heavy duty glue for the lettering. the humidity in the building can cause the paper to bubble.

JUDGING & PRIZE INFORMATION

Age Divisions:

4th - 5th grades | 6th - 8th grades | 9th - 12th grades

All Exhibits will be judged as follows:

- All excellent will receive a Blue Ribbon (\$15.00)
- All good will receive a Red Ribbon (\$12.00)
- All fair will receive a White Ribbon (\$9.00)

All exhibits (excluding Grand Champion) will be re-judged for best in each of the following categories in each age division. These winners will receive a certificate and \$10.

- Neatest Overall

- Best Floor Display

All Blue Ribbons will be re-judged & Grand Champion will be awarded for each age division.

- Use bright colors and good contrast
- · Check spelling!

Themed

- · Stick to one clear idea
- Use a catchy title
- · Add clip art, personal photos, or stock images
