New Shampoo, Soap or Feminine Hygiene Products. Students earn Clover Points for participating, but this is not mandatory.

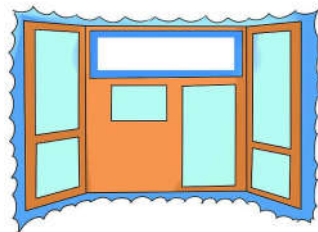
Georgia 4-H Forms
