Poultry Judging

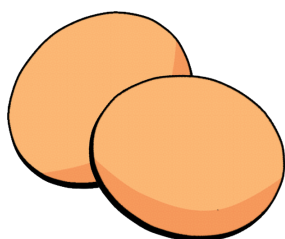
