Results from UGA Radon Program.

Radon is an invisible gas that is naturally occurring. It is the second leading cause of lung cancer behind smoking.

An estimated 21,000 Americans die of radon-induced lung cancer yearly.

79 radon test kits were submitted for analysis.



13 homes had elevated levels of radon.



## 8 counties

had elevated radon levels, increasing Georgians' risk for lung cancer.
