## **CHANGES FOR FALL 2020**

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, UGA Extension Fulton County and Fulton County 4-H have suspended all inperson programs. We hope and plan to resume faceto-face instruction at a later date when public health conditions allow for safe gatherings.

In the meantime, we are offering a variety of virtual programs, including science, cooking, and life skills programs. This fall will also include monthly community service projects and contests! Your child will receive a monthly newsletter which details upcoming participation opportunities.

## **WHY 4-H?**

For more than 10 years, National 4-H Council has partnered with Tufts University to study the effectiveness of 4-H youth development programs. This longitudinal study began in 2002 and has surveyed over 7,000 youth from diverse backgrounds across 42 states. According to this study, 4-Hers are:

- Four times more likely to give back to their communities
- Twice as likely to make healthier choices
- Twice as likely to participate in STEM activities

- Junior: Youth in 7th & 8th grade
- Senior: Youth in 9th 12th grade

## WHO CAN PARTICIPATE IN 4-H?

All youth, grades K-12, residing or attending school in Fulton County may join 4-H.

Any person, regardless of race, color, national origin, gender, or disability may enroll as a 4-H member.

4-H does not charge dues or require uniforms. However, there are fees and dress associated with certain events and programs. Activities and events available to youth vary by grade.



## 4-H PROJECT ACHIEVEMENT



<u>4-H Project Achievement</u> is a cornerstone in the Georgia 4-H program. Students select a topic of interest and prepare a demonstration including visuals. As students progress the competition also includes a portfolio of yearly activities. Project Achievement teaches youth important public speaking skills, provides practice in research and organizing information, and encourages youth to learn more about a topic they are passionate about – there are over 50 categories from which students can choose! This year your child will be invited and encouraged to participate in 4-H Project Achievement, including the district competition to be held in February 2020 (4th-6th grade) or March 2020 (7th-12th grade). There is no cost to participate in Project Achievement.
