WHAT IS PROJECT SAFE?

Georgia 4-H Project S.A.F.E. (Shooting Awareness, Fun, and Education) develops life skills through shooting and target sports. Youth compete in a variety of disciplines including BB, archery, and shotgun.

Fulton County 4-H will offer a BB team in the Buckhead area in winter 2019. We are currently recruiting additional coaches to start new BB teams in the north and south parts of Fulton County as well as to offer teams in other disciplines.



WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

The Fulton County 4-H BB Team is open to youth in 4th-8th grade. Participating youth MUST be chaperoned by a parent during all practices and competitions.



WHAT IS INVOLVED?

4-H Shooting Sports are a family commitment. Parents of participating team members must complete the University of Georgia's volunteer screening and training process. Additionally, youth must be accompanied by a parent for all practices and competitions. Parents serve as line coaches during practices and competitions and are a necessary component to ensure youth safety.

A BB Team interest meeting will be held in fall 2018, and practices will begin in January 2019. Limited spots are available on the team. Team members are responsible for team dues and providing their own BB gun.
