- 4-Hers are supervised by 4-H staff and background checked adult leaders.
- The cabins are nicely furnished with air conditioning, bunk beds, and bathrooms.
- All meals are served in the dining hall.
- Rock Eagle is located near Eatonton, GA, about one and a half hours from Atlanta.
- **Transportation to and from camp is not provided by Fulton County 4-H.**

- Non-refundable deposit of **\$100.00** is due at registration to reserve your child's space.
- Deadline to pay the final payment of **\$270.00** is **Friday, May 1**. Payment installments are available.
- Payments can be made via check or Visa/Master Card/Discover. All checks should be made out to *Fulton County Extension/4-H*.
- Last day to request refunds is May 1, 2019. A partial refund will be given only if requested in writing and approved by the 4-H agent. Please allow 6-8 weeks for a refund to be processed.
- Limited partial **scholarships** are available. Scholarship applications are due **March 4** and can be downloaded from our website ([www.ugaextension.org/fulton](http://www.ugaextension.org/fulton)).
- Camp space is limited and campers are accepted on a first come, first serve basis. Once all available spaces are filled, a wait list will be utilized to fill any spaces which may become open.
