- Safety measures are stressed; swimming is allowed only under supervision of qualified lifeguards and adult leaders.
- 4-Hers are supervised by 4-H staff and background checked adult leaders.
- **Campers sleep in tents and cook meals over a campfire or grill.**
- Rock Eagle 4-H Center is located 1.5 hours away from Atlanta, near Eatonton, GA.
- **Transportation to and from camp is not provided by Fulton County 4-H.**
- **Optional white water rafting trip will be available at the beginning of the week (Sunday-Monday) for an additional \$75.**

- Non-refundable deposit of \$100.00 is due at registration to reserve your child's space.
- Deadline to pay the final payment of **\$265.00** is **Friday, May 1**. Payment installments are available.
- Payments can be made via check or Visa/Master Card/Discover. All checks should be made out to *Fulton County Extension/4-H*.
- Last day to request refunds is May 1, 2019. A partial refund will be given only if requested in writing and approved by the 4-H agent. Please allow 6-8 weeks for a refund to be processed.
- Camp space is limited and campers are accepted on a first come, first serve basis. Once all available spaces are filled, a wait list will be utilized to fill any spaces which may become open.
