The purpose of the teen leaders is to *ease* the job of the adult chaperones, *bond* with the campers and *encourage* their future participation in 4-H. Selection will be based on experience in leadership, particularly with Cloverleaf age, having demonstrated responsibility and initiative at previous activities, active participation in the Fulton County 4-H program, and the number of leaders needed. Applicant must be cheerful and willing to work long hours without complaint.

Applicants must be in the 9th through 12th grade during the 2018-2019 school year.

Accepted applicants must complete a 4-H Certified Teen Leader Training prior to attending Cloverleaf Camp. A training is tentatively scheduled for the last week of May 2019.
