The fundraiser runs from October 20th through November 19th. All money and order forms are due at the 4-H Office no later than 5:30 PM on Wednesday, November 19th. Peanut orders can be picked up the same day from 1:00 – 5:30 PM at the 4-H Office.

We also have scholarships for our top sellers! The 1st place winner will receive \$150, 2nd place \$125, and 3rd place \$100. Plus, anyone who sells \$100 or more will earn a special long sleeve 4-H t-shirt!

For those participating in **Shooting Sports**, you can use the Peanut Fundraiser as an activity. Selling 18 cans counts as 1 activity, and selling 3 cases (36 cans) counts as 2 activities. Each case contains 12 cans.


onday, February 16th. The ownership and tagging deadline for showing in the county show is Friday, December 5, 2025.


Cloverleaf Project Achievement
