rady County 4-H is kicking off its Spring Fundraiser. For the next 8 weeks, you will have the opportunity to sell Vidalia Onions to help generate funds for the Grady County 4-H Program as well as to earn scholarship money to help pay your way to 4-H Summer Camp.

Once the camp scholarships are paid, the remaining profits from the onion fundraiser helps pay for Project Achievement, all of our various judging team programs, the "Summer Fun" program, and of course our Annual 4-H Awards Banquet.

The fundraiser will run from March 7th through May 3rd. All money and forms are due to the 4-H Office by Tuesday, May 3rd at 5:30 pm. Pick-up will be Tuesday, May 17th, 3:30-6:00pm at the Farmers Market.

Sell Onions to pay your way to Summer Camp: As a way to help you pay your registration fees for summer camp, we will once again allow you to use the profits from your total sales to put towards your registration fee. You must first pay the \$75 registration fee and then you can use the profits from your onion sales to pay the remaining \$255 for Cloverleaf and \$305 for Junior & Senior Camp.

Please pay close attention to the green order form for all the specific details regarding prices for the various size bags of onions as well as the tips on how to sell the onions.

As always, please get your parents permission before you start selling onions.

If you are interested in showing cattle next year, now is the time you need to be locating your steer or heifer.

Cattle producers who raise show steers and heifers are beginning to market those animals for the 2022 - 2023 show season. The upcoming show season for cattle will get started in July '22 and run through the state shows in Feb. '23.

Birthdates of cattle for next year:

It is suggested that steers be born after August 1, 2021.

Heifers must be born after January 1, 2021. You can show purebred or commercial heifers.

Summer Camp Registration is Still Open!

e realize summer is still 3 months away, but you will find information for all age groups included on this page.

Let us tell you to begin with that we will once again allow you to use the profits from your Vidalia Onion Sales in March -May to pay your camp registration fee. You will have to pay the non-refundable deposit out of your pocket and then you can use your onion profits to pay the remaining portion of your camp fee. For all of the camps, the deposit is \$75.

When you look at the camp registration deadlines, please keep in mind the sooner you pay your camp deposit the more likely you are to guarantee yourself a spot on the bus. We will continue to promote all 3 camps until they are full for the week we will be attending camp.

Senior Camp @ Rock Eagle 4-4 Center

4-H'ers in grades 9-12 are eligible to attend Sr. Camp. This year, Senior Camp is headed to the Rock Eagle 4-H Center. Camp is scheduled for July 4-8 and will cost \$380. Senior 4-H'ers, this is your chance to socialize with other high school age 4-H'ers and not have those pesky cloverleaf or junior age 4-H'ers hanging

Junior Camp @ Georgia 4-4 at Camp Jekyll


Cloverleaf Camp @ Wahsega 4-4 Center

ow would you like to spend a week at a mountain getaway! This year, Cloverleaf Camp for 4th - 6th graders will be held at Wahsega 4-H Center the week of June 13-17. The cost for the week of camp is \$330. This covers all camp activities, camp t-shirt, transportation, insurance, lodging and camp meals. It can be broken down into 3 easy payments due as follows: March 4^{th} - \$75 Non-Refundable Deposit, April 8^{th} - \$125, and May 6^{th} - \$130 Final Payment. We have 5 spots left!

There is beauty in the woods and they call it Wahsega 4-H Center. Rustic but accommodating, campers enjoy a "hillbilly" theme in the midst of Appalachia, complete with waterfall and trout stream. There is time to go hiking or to be challenged by the ropes course. There are classes in Mountain Hiking, with Wildlife Tracks & Signs, Forest Ecology & Herpetology (Snakes), Ultimate Frisbee, archery, Stream Ecology and the Low Ropes Challenge Course.
