

Spring is Poultry Judging Time!

Informative and fun program for Grades 5-12

Why poultry? Let's just say "the cows sent us." Poultry judging is a state-wide competition that involves:

- Grading internal and external egg quality
- Identifying cuts of chicken
- Evaluating Ready to Cook nuggets and patties
- Judging past egg production
- Stating oral reasons for class placement

Poultry Judging is a spring time Judging Team offered each school year, so please consider signing up. No past experience is needed. You will learn how to select the best chicken and eggs at the grocery store.

Five weekly practices will be held evenings from 6:30pm–8:00pm. Three are on Tuesday and two on Monday. We are planning in-person practices (750 S. Perry St, 2nd floor, Lawrenceville, GA 30046) in March and first week in April. No spring break practice. Our area competition is in April on a weekday during the 3rd or 4th week of the month. Exact date and location has not been announced by state yet. Only the top two Senior teams (9-12 graders) move on to State Competition in May.

Sign-up by the last Tuesday in February to allow us time to prepare your study material before we start.
