Data collected between September 1 to 30, 2025.

Results from UGA Radon Program.

Radon is an invisible, naturally occurring gas and is the second leading cause of lung cancer. 21,000 Americans die of radon-induced lung cancer yearly.

76 radon test kits were submitted for analysis.



12 homes had elevated levels of radon.

19.35%

Nearly 1 in 5 homes tested had elevated radon levels this month.



10 counties

had elevated radon levels, increasing Georgians' risk for lung cancer.

Gwinnett County had the highest radon level at

19.7 pCi/L

which is nearly 5 times the EPA's Action Level!
