Other Opportunities

C-4 4-H Science Club—After school club at Creekside School monthly. When registration opens, 24 students can join. Provide fun STEAM activities.

4-H Clover Sprouts Club—After school club at the 4-H Office in Hamilton monthly. For grades 4th—6th . Fun STEAM and other activities.

4-H Clover Buds Club—After school club at the 4-H Office in Hamilton monthly. For grades 1st—3rd . Fun STEAM and other activities.

Cotton Boll and Consumer Judging Team—Learn how to make good consumer decisions. This year's items are: Laptops, Sandals, Energy drinks and Fitness equipment.

Poultry Judging Team—This team learns about hens, eggs and chicken parts. There are 10 different classes. Such as external eggs, candling eggs, ready to cook chicken parts, live birds and more.
