



Harris County 4-H Archery Team 2024-25

Archery Team dues are \$150 for the year. 4-H staff will work to ensure the team has good targets, range and Certified Volunteer Coaches. 4-H pays for the volunteer coaches' trainings. Please help secure sponsorships to help with the team costs.

- We will have an **Archery Sponsorship program** to help with expenses. Students will receive half of the sponsor donation to help cover their team fee. Example: A company donates \$50. The team member who got that sponsor will receive a credit toward dues of \$25.
- Sponsors who donate a minimum of \$50 will have their name on the team practice shirt. We will promote the sponsors on our social media outlets and website randomly during the season.
- Team members will have a competition jersey and practice t-shirt (sponsors on back).

- Wear closed toe shoes (also for parent volunteers who plan to go on the range)
- Water or sport drink
- Hat

Practices are on the Harris County 4-H Archery Range on Hwy 116 in Hamilton. Turn in the entrance for the Harris County Agricultural Center and the range is visible.

Practices are on Sunday afternoons. Begin at 1:30 or 2:00 pm each week. There will be some other practices during the year. These will be announced by coaches as needed.
