Archery Team dues are \$125 for the year. 4-H staff will work to ensure the team has good targets, range and Certified Volunteer Coaches. 4-H pays for the volunteer coaches' trainings. Please help secure sponsorships to help with the team costs.

- We will have an **Archery Sponsorship program** to help with expenses. Students will receive half of the sponsor donation to help cover their team fee. Example: A company donates \$50. The team member who got that sponsor will receive a credit toward dues of \$25.

Hunter Safety Course: All archers in 7th – 12th grade must have taken and completed the Georgia Hunter Safety Course prior to first competition. Once it is completed, send me the certificate number. This only has to be taken once.

For Practices:

- Bring all your equipment. Bow, arrows, quiver, arm guard, etc.
- Wear closed toe shoes (also for parent volunteers who plan to go on the range)
- Water or sport drink
- Hat

Age Groups:

Cloverleaf Archer

- 4th – 6th graders
- Bow type options: Genesis type (equipped with an arrow rest and nocking point only), Compound or Recurve
- Indoor Distance: 60cm full-face targets; 330 round with 30 arrows shot in 10 ends of 3 arrows at 18 meters; 2 minutes to shoot each 3-arrow end
- Indoor Novice (Genesis type bow): distance of 9 meters
- Outdoor Distance Novice: Two ends of six arrows each at 30, 20, and 10 meters (122 cm target face): 36 total arrows
- Outdoor Compound: Two ends of six arrows each at 40 and 30 meters (122 cm target face) and two ends of six arrows each at 20 meters - 80cm 6 ring target face: 36 total arrows

Junior Archer

- 7th and 8th graders
- Bow type options: Compound or Recurve
- Indoor Distance: choice of either a 40cm full-face target or a 40 cm 3-spot target; 330 round with 30 arrows shot in 10 ends of 3 arrows at 18 meters; 2 minutes to shoot each 3-arrow end
- Outdoor Compound Distance: Four ends of six arrows each at 50 (122 cm target face), and four ends of six arrows each at 40, and 30 meters (80cm 6 ring target face): 72 total arrows

Senior Archer

- 9th – 12th graders
- Bow type options: Compound or Recurve
- Indoor Distance: choice of either a 40cm full-face target or a 40 cm 3-spot target; 330 round with 30 arrows shot in 10 ends of 3 arrows at 18 meters; 2 minutes to shoot each 3-arrow end
- Outdoor Compound Distance: Three ends of six arrows each at 60 and 50 meters (122 cm target face) and three ends of six arrows each at 40 and 30 meters (80cm 6 ring target face): 72 total arrows
