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2021 Cloverleaf Camp Registration Information

Thank you for your patience over the past couple of months waiting on camp information. In an effort to maintain the health and safety of campers, staff, and volunteers, camp spaces have been substantially reduced from previous years. Each county has been tasked with determining the camp registration process. Hart County 4-H has elected to hold an early registration date for those students who participated in a judging team/livestock show team or DPA during the 2020-2021 school year as they have always been promised. The early sign up date is Tuesday, April 27 from 8:00 am -5:00 pm at the 4-H Office. We will open up any other available camp spaces to all other 4th, 5th & 6th grade students on **Wednesday, April 28 from 8:00 am-5:00 pm at the 4-H Office.** Registration is done on a **first-come, first serve** basis to be fair.

Camp Location and Date

Rock Eagle 4-H Center (Eatonton, Georgia)
Monday, June 7- Thursday, June 10, 2021

Eligible Campers

Camp spaces are strictly limited to 4th, 5th, and 6th graders in the current 2020-2021 school year who reside in Hart County or attend a Hart County School (public, private, or homeschool).

Cost and Payment Agreement

The camp fee of \$290 covers lodging, meals, camp t-shirt, and 4-H center fees. The registration form and \$100 non-refundable deposit are to be turned in to Hart County 4-H at sign up. The remaining balance of \$190 will be divided into 2 CASH payments: \$95 due Wed., May 12 and \$95 due Wed., June 2. If the balance payments are not paid on time, your camper(s) will lose his/her spot(s) and will be replaced by another 4-H'er on the waiting list.

Refund Policy

2021 Refund Considerations due to COVID-19 PRIOR to the START of CAMP:

To support families experiencing adverse impacts from the COVID-19 pandemic, including job loss or care for sick family members, if the need arises to cancel camper registration prior to arrival at camp, campers are eligible for a full refund (including deposit). In promotion of healthy camp environments, if campers are ill or have a known or suspected exposure to COVID-19 prior to arrival at camp, they will need to cancel their registration and are eligible for a full refund (including deposit). Georgia 4-H will continue to monitor the COVID-19 pandemic and its impacts. If it is determined that any week of camp has to be cancelled or rescheduled, campers are eligible for full refund (including deposit).

2021 Refund Considerations due to COVID-19 AFTER the START of CAMP:

The cohort model employed this summer, used to address important health and safety concerns, may require some campers and leaders to isolate and leave camp based on symptoms, exposure, and/or contact tracing. Partial refunds will be given in that case.

Refund Considerations UNRELATED to COVID-19:

Requests for refunds that result from cancellations or leaving camp early for reasons not related to COVID-19 will be reviewed using existing procedures.

_____ **Transportation Agreement**

Since we have such a small group, we will meet at Bell's Shopping Center and travel down on the Hart County 4-H minibus and 4-H van to and from Rock Eagle 4-H Center (Eatonton, GA). Everyone in the vehicles will be required to wear masks, both students and chaperones, and sit socially distant from each other to the best of our ability. By initialing on this line, you are confirming that you understand and agree to the transportation policy to and from camp.

_____ **Early Dismissal from Camp Agreement**

In an effort to have all parties involved with camp prepared in the case of a disciplinary event, illness, or exposure to COVID-19, the parent or guardian will be responsible to pick their child up if they are notified to do so. By initialing on this line above, you are confirming that in the event of an early camp dismissal, you will be responsible for providing transportation for your camper.

_____ **COVID-19 Negative Testing Agreement**

In 2020, the Governor's Executive Order required a negative COVID-19 test prior to participation in overnight summer camp activities; if this requirement is included in 2021 guidance, we will incorporate it into plans for overnight summer activities as soon as we become aware of the mandate. By initialing on this line, you are confirming that you will adhere to this requirement and provide documentation to Hart County 4-H in the event of this requirement.

_____ **Mask and Social Distancing Agreement**

We can and should prepare for the requirement to wear masks in indoor spaces and outdoors when social distancing is not possible. We will continue to use social distancing as an important tool for preventing the transmission of COVID-19. By initialing on this line, you are confirming you and your camper(s) will adhere to Georgia 4-H's guidelines.
