### **CONTEST RULES:**

1. This is an individual event.
2. An index card must accompany the entry with the 4-H member's name, grade, county, division and class number in which the item is to be exhibited.
3. Dried, non-perishable agricultural products (such as gourds, dried corn, peanuts, etc.) must be used and may be penetrated (with pins, earrings, etc.).
4. Fresh vegetables and agricultural products which may spoil may not be used.
5. No artificial agricultural products may be used.
6. Exhibits must be no larger the 24" in any direction.
7. No perishable items may be used as decoration for the exhibit.
8. 4-H'er must provide a 3 x 5 index card with a list of supplies used.
9. Exhibits will be judged on originality (25 pts), overall appearance (25 pts), and adherence to rules (50 pts).
