Project Achievement



Project Achievement is a fun way of sharing something you have learned. 4-H'ers share what they have learned by presenting a presentation. By doing a presentation, you will learn how to research a topic, organize your ideas, and develop skills of expressing yourself to others.

You will enjoy going to Project Achievement! It will be **Saturday, February 13, 2021 at Rock Eagle 4-H Center in Eatonton, Georgia.** You will compete in your project area against other 4-H'ers your age and get to experience getting up in front of others to share what you have learned. You'll be proud of yourself just for participating!!

There is a \$10 non-refundable participation fee. (The trip actually cost \$35 per child but Hart County 4-H will cover the balance of the trip for all your hard work.) (Fee is due by Nov. 20)

To sign up for Project Achievement, you need to have a parent or guardian **call the 4-H HOTLINE at 706-856-5327.** We can take **four 4th & 5th graders, in any combination, and four 6th graders in all project areas.** **Sign up is on a first-come, first-serve basis.** 4-H'ers who competed at Project Achievement last year have already signed up. **4-H Project Fair winners get to sign up Wed., Nov. 11 from 8:00-10:00 am. All other 4-H'ers may sign up Wed., Nov. 11 from 10:00 am until 5:00 pm.**

Please select at least 5 project areas below. This is just in case the project you really want is full when your parents call. Your parents will have some other choices from which to choose.

Remember you can ONLY register by calling the 4-H HOTLINE at 706-856-5327. If the line is busy, please keep trying.

First time Project Achievement parents will have to attend a mandatory meeting which will be held virtually on Tues., Nov. 17 at 6 pm. If you will be unable to attend a meeting, please call Brandi Shiflet at 706-376-3134.

Varieties Available:

Gold Rush: Half peck- \$8; Peck- \$15; Bushel- \$50

Fuji: Half peck- \$8; Peck- \$15; Bushel- \$50

Pink Lady: Half peck- \$13; Peck- \$25; Bushel- \$72

A half peck is approximately 6.25 pounds. A peck is approx. 12.5 pounds. A bushel is approx. 44 pounds.

Apples will be ready for pick up on Tues., Nov. 17th at the 4-H Office from 8 am-5:30 pm.

For each order placed in your name, you will receive 10 points toward the 4-H Reward Trip.

Canned Pet Food Project

For this month's service project we are collecting cans of dog and cat food to donate to the Humane Society. **You can bring in any type of canned dog or cat food. Make sure you label your can with your first and last name and teacher's name** to receive your 25 points for participating. *(Remember that you only receive 25 total points for participating in each community service project—not 25 points per item donated.)*
