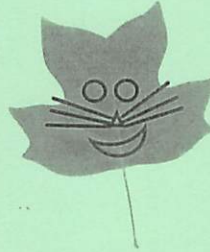




INSIDE THE CLOVER

Rabies Clinic

Is your dog or cat up-to-date with their Rabies vaccination? If not, join us at our **Rabies Clinic on Wed., June 22 or Wed., June 29 from 5:30-6:30 pm at Beggs Farm Supply,** located at 67 Eagle Grove School Rd in Canon. **Cost is \$8 per pet (cash or check).**



This is a drive-thru clinic but in some cases you may be asked to get your pet out of the vehicle or to hold your pet during the vaccination. Pets should be on a leash or in a carrier. It might be helpful to have an extra person with you if you have more than one pet.

These 1-year rabies vaccinations will be administered by Dr. Keifer with Hartwell Animal Hospital and his staff.
