Welcome



Project Fair

Pick a topic you enjoy. Write a one-to-two page research-based, informational report. Make a poster about your report. The possibilities are endless! Example: If you like strawberries, research how to grow them or their nutritional value and write your report. Then make a poster about what you wrote including pictures of things you talk about in your report. Don't forget to put a title on your poster.

Guidelines for the report:

- *Must be research-based
- *Has to be written in your own words



*One main idea must be about a career related to your topic (Example: If you wrote about growing strawberries, you could talk about a farmer or Agricultural research or marketing). Include things like training or education needed, examples of job duties, salary range and/or work environment expected.

*List books or websites you used to get your information at the end of the report.

Please don't forget to <u>put your first and last name and your teacher's name on the back of your poster AND on your report.</u> Your <u>report should be stapled/taped/paper clipped to the back of your poster.</u> Do NOT glue report to poster.

Please <u>only</u> turn in a poster and report. All other visual aids <u>will not</u> be accepted. <u>Please don't put toys or other 3D objects on your poster</u>. <u>These usually fall off and get lost or messed up.</u>

All project fair entries will be judged and prizes will be awarded. This is <u>worth 50 points toward the end of the year reward trip.</u> You will need this report and poster later in the year to share with your class. This will help us with our public speaking skills. **Your project is DUE to your teacher BEFORE Wed., Aug. 30.**

Great Southeast Pollinator Census

Become a citizen scientist and join us on <u>Fri., Aug. 18 from</u> 3:00-5:00 pm at the Hart County Botanical Gardens for the Great Southeast Pollinator Census! We will have information on various pollinators and you will get to pick a plant and count pollinators for 15 minutes. The information that you record during that time will be shared with the University of Georgia and help them learn more about pollinators and help them develop tools to protect pollinators in the future.

This is a drop-in event so you can come by anytime between 3:00 pm and 5:00 pm. The Hart County Botanical Garden is located at the new Recreation Department fields next to Hart EMC on Elberton Highway. Those 4-H'ers that participate will receive 25 points towards the 4-H Reward Trip.

If you are interested in showing hogs, dairy or beef heifers, steers, sheep, or goats please call the 4-H Office no later than Aug. 30th for more information. The Market Goat and Market Lamb season has already begun but all other species begin their show season soon. This is a great learning experience for you and your family!

Live to Give Project



We are collecting pop tabs (tabs from canned drinks) to donate to the Ronald McDonald House. 4-H'ers from across the state will put all their pop tabs together to recycle for money we will then donate to one of the Ronald McDonald Houses in Georgia. They use the money received from our donation to help pay the house utility bills and offer

services to families that stay with them.

If you would like to help with this project, bring your pop tabs in a ziplock bag. Please <u>put</u> <u>your first and last name and your teacher's name on a piece of paper inside the bag.</u>
We will <u>collect these on Fri., October 27th</u>. You will receive 25 points toward the 4-H Reward trip for 100 or more pop tabs. (*Twenty – five points is the <u>maximum</u> number of points you can receive for pop tabs.*)

Ten Points:

*Participate in 4-H fundraiser/activity

Twenty-five Points:

*Participate in 4-H Community Service Project or Contest/Activity of the Month

Fifty Points:

*Participate in 4-H Project Fair

*Present demonstration at 4-H Meeting

One Hundred Points:

*Compete in District Project Achievement (DPA) or Judging Event or State Animal Show

Everything you turn in must have your first and last name and your homeroom teacher's name on it to receive points.

A student in each classroom will be recognized for having the most points at the end of the year, as well as a student from each grade level at each school.



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
