



# Mellow on the Yellow Lamb and Goat Classic Rules and Guidelines



1. The show is open to 4-H (including pre-club) and FFA members.
2. All Georgia 4-H and FFA State Livestock Rules and Regulations will be followed.
  - Exception is that you can show all five goats/lambs at the show, whereas, at State you are allowed to show three.
3. For goats: only wethers and does allowed. NO BUCKS. All animals will be shown as market. Wethers and does will be shown together.
4. For lambs: only wethers and ewes allowed. No RAMS. All animals will be shown as market. Wethers and ewes will be shown together.
5. All goats must be dehorned or have horns tipped.
6. All goats/lambs must be ear tagged and/or tattooed.
7. This show will allow bracing.
8. No clipping of shearing of animals on show premise.
9. **Entry Fee: The entry fee per animal is \$25.**
  - Late entries will be charged an additional \$10.00 if postmarked after July 20<sup>th</sup>
10. **Showmanship:**
  - Each exhibitor must show their own animal in showmanship. The animal must be entered in the show and owned by the exhibitor.
  - Showmanship classes will be done by grade level with division winners receiving belt buckles.
    - Divisions: Elementary, Middle, High
11. **Weight Classes:**
  - Exhibitors must show their own goat/ lamb in class. If the exhibitor has more than one goat/lamb in a class they can have another exhibitor show for them.
    - This must be cleared with show officials before showing.
  - Animals will be weighed and divided into classes by show officials.
    - After the animal leaves the scales there will be no re-weighs.
  - There are no weight limits.
12. Payout and Prizes
  - Amount of prize money will be based on entries.
  - Payouts will be for the following:
    - Showmanship: Payout for Top 3 in each grade. Winners from each grade will come back for division drive. Winner of each division will receive a Belt Buckle.
    - Class: Top 5 individuals in each weight classes along with Grand and Reserve in weight
13. Pens will be assigned by show committee prior to arrival.
  - Unapproved pen alterations are not allowed.
  - There will be at least two lambs/goats in each pen.
14. A certificate of Veterinary Inspection is required with the individual identification and the following statement:

**Flock of origin is free from Foot Rot, Scabies, Contagious Ecthyma (soremouth), Cutaneous Fungal Lesions, Scrapie or any other Infectious disease.**  
**All Does must have a USDA approved scrapie tag in the ear.**  
**Registration numbers will not serve as the scrapie tag for the show.**

15. The Newton County FFA Chapters reserve the right to review the rules and make changes if necessary. All decisions made by the Newton County FFA Chapters are final.
16. Absolutely no refunds will be given.
17. No dogs shall be allowed in the show arena or in the lamb and goat barn.
18. Weigh in will be Saturday, August 3<sup>rd</sup>
  - Lambs will weigh in from 7:00am - 8:30am
  - Goats will weigh in from 10:00am - 11:30am
19. Barns will open at 6:00pm on Friday, August 2<sup>nd</sup> and close at 8:00pm and reopen at 6:00am on Saturday, August 3<sup>rd</sup>.
20. The Lamb show will start at 9:00am and the Goat Show will start 30 minutes after the lamb show OR no earlier than 12:00pm.
21. The Newton County Livestock Program accepts no responsibility nor assumes any risk for injury to the exhibitor or animal due to or resulting from participation in the Yellow on the Mellow.
